Introduction

Solantis LLC (hereinafter "the Company", "we", "us", "our", "ours" and "ourselves" as appropriate), is authorized and regulated by the Financial Authorities of Saint Lucia with license number 202500785.

This Cookie Policy applies to our website <u>www.solantis.pro</u>, its subdomains, mobile applications, and other digital platforms operated by the Company. It does not cover third-party websites or services that may be linked from our platforms, which are governed by their respective cookie and privacy policies.

1. Definition

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (e.g., computer, tablet, or smartphone) when you access websites. They are used to improve website performance, remember your preferences, and collect data for analytical purposes.

Cookies can be classified as follows:

First-party cookies: Created and used by the website you are visiting for its own functionality.

Third-party cookies: Created by external services integrated into the website to enhance functionality

or track activity.

Session cookies: Temporary cookies that expire when you close your browser.

Persistent cookies: Remain on your device for a set duration or until manually deleted.

Cookies typically do not store personal information directly but may link to data you provide to enhance your user experience.

2. Why are Cookies Useful?

Cookies enable a more efficient and personalized browsing experience by allowing websites to recognize your device and preferences.

On our website, cookies are used to:

- > Ensure core functionality and smooth operation.
- > Remember your preferences, such as language and region.
- > Analyze website performance and user behavior for optimization.
- > Support personalized advertising and track marketing campaign effectiveness.

3. Categorization of Cookies

We utilize the following categories of cookies to enhance the user experience and functionality of our Website:

Essential Cookies: Necessary for the basic operation of the Website, enabling secure logins and consistent

navigation. Without these cookies, key features may not work properly.

Performance Cookies: Provide insights into how users interact with the Website, helping us improve functionality

and design. These cookies do not store personally identifiable information.

Functional Cookies: Allow us to remember user preferences and provide enhanced, personalized features,

such as language selection or saved login details.

Advertising or Track user behavior across websites to deliver personalized advertisements and measure the

Targeting Cookies: success of ad campaigns. These cookies are optional and can be disabled at any time.

Please be aware that if you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully benefit from all the features of our website or maybe experience errors at some point or function.

The cookies used on our websites:

- > Do not store personal data such as passwords.
- > Do not access any other information stored on your computer.
- > Do not compromise the security of your device(s).
